 A Correct Motive - For His Glory and not our Own.

James 4:2,3

You want something but don't get it. You kill and covet, but you cannot have what you want. You quarrel and fight. You do not have, because you do not ask God. When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures.

Prayer is two-way fellowship and communication with God. You speak to God and He speaks to you. It is not a one-way conversation. Prayer includes listening as well. In fact, what God says in prayer is far more important than what you say. Prayer is a relationship, not just a religious activity. Prayer is designed more to adjust you to God than to adjust God to you. You need to pray because of what God wants to do in and through your life.
