#### A Simple Key to Certain Success Genesis 24

- He turned to God with an “I can't; You can” attitude.

Isaiah 31:1 (NIV)

Woe to those who go down to Egypt for help, who rely on horses, who trust in the multitude of their chariots and in the great strength of their horsemen, but do not look to the Holy One of Israel, or seek help from the LORD.

Luke 1:34-37 (NIV)

And Mary said to the angel, "How shall this be, since I have no husband?" And the angel said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be called holy, the Son of God. ... For with God nothing will be impossible."

- His motives were pure and his heart was right.

Verse 12 - "... grant me success today, and show kindness to my master Abraham."

James 4:2-3 (NIV)

You want something but don't get it. You kill and covet, but you cannot have what you want. You quarrel and fight. You do not have, because you do not ask God. When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures.

- He followed ALL that God said to do.

Verses 21-22 – "...the man silently watched her to see whether or not the LORD had made his journey a success. After the camels had finished drinking, the man took a gold ring weighing half a shekel, and for her wrists two bracelets weighing 10 shekels of gold."

Verse 27 – "As for me, the LORD has led me on the journey to the house of my master's relatives."

- He gave God all the credit privately and publicly.

Verses 26-27 – "Then the man bowed down, worshiped the LORD, and said, "Praise the LORD, the God of my master Abraham, who has not withheld His kindness and faithfulness from my master."
