Current Ministry Roles:

Worship Pastor- Facilitate the worship of the church through music ministry. This includes shepherding the worship and tech team members and developing the team members to be excellent in their faith walk, teamwork, and levels of performance. Oversee the church's technical team for video streaming and production for the various ministries. The team includes a staff of 7 individuals and 75 volunteers.

School of Worship (SOW)- SOW was formed as a process to develop, recruit, and assimilate volunteers for the worship ministry. It is an 8-week program to develop spiritually and musically persons for work in the ministry. Training consists of biblically defining worship and instrument lessons, with the desire to develop personal worshippers who use their gifts for the glory of God.

Communications Team- The role of the team is to effectively, accurately, and quickly communicate information. This team is also the creative arts team staffed by three people and several volunteers. This team helps plans for special services such as Easter and Christmas and handles the website and social media presence for the church. They also produce the weekly online worship services.

The Porch- A ministry to young adults, Partnered with Watermark Church in Dallas, where sound and relevant teaching is live-streamed every Tuesday night. Reaches app. 150 young adults each week. This role is to shepherd, equip and resource the volunteer leadership teams.
