Jonah 1:14b (CSB)

“...For You, Lord, have done just as You pleased.”

Matthew 12:40-41 (HCSB)

For as Jonah was in the belly of the huge fish three days and three nights, so the Son of Man will be in the heart of the earth three days and three nights. The men of Nineveh will stand up at the judgment with this generation and condemn it, because they repented at Jonah’s preaching; and look—something greater than Jonah is here.

I. Sovereign over Nature (Chap. 1, 2, 4)

II. Sovereign over Nations (Chap. 3)

Acts 11:18 (HCSB)

III. Sovereign over Human Nature (Chap. 4)

Questions to ask —

- Is it right for me to be angry – at God or others?
- Am I seeking Kingdom victories or personal gain?
- Is my heart selfish or am I putting others first?
- Am I more concerned with my comfort, than compassion for others?
- Am I following God’s will or my own?
