Psalm 66

Psalm 66:1-20 (NIV)

Shout with joy to God, all the earth! Sing the glory of his name; make his praise glorious! Say to God, "How awesome are your deeds! All the earth bows down to you; they sing praise to you, they sing praise to your name." Come and see what God has done, how awesome his works in man’s behalf! He turned the sea into dry land, they passed through the waters on foot — come, let us rejoice in him. He rules forever by his power, his eyes watch the nations — let not the rebellious rise up against him. He has preserved our lives and kept our feet from slipping. I cried out to him with my mouth; if I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened; but God has surely listened and heard my voice in prayer. Praise be to God, who has not rejected my prayer or withheld his love from me!

II. Celebrate What God has Done.


