

Our Living Savior 1 Corinthians 15

I Corinthians 15:3-8 (NIV)

For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, and that he appeared to Peter, and then to the Twelve. After that, he appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep. Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles, and last of all he appeared to me also..."

I. Jesus is Our Promised Savior

Verse 3-4 "For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures."

Acts 13:23 (ESV)

"God has brought to Israel a Savior, Jesus, as he promised."

Websters Dictionary 1828 edition:

"Savior: One that saves or preserves; but properly applied only to Jesus Christ, the Redeemer, who has opened the way to everlasting salvation by his obedience and death, and who is therefore called the Savior, by way of distinction, the Savior of men, the Savior of the world."

Mark 10:33-34 (NIV)

Again he took the Twelve aside and told them what was going to happen to him. ...He said, "the Son of Man will be betrayed to the chief priests. They will condemn him to death and will hand him over to the Gentiles, who will mock him, flog him and kill him. Three days later he will rise."
