• **Know God—Worship Services**

John 17:3 (ESV)

This is eternal life: that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.

• **Find Community –Life Groups**

Romans 12:4-5 (NIV)

Just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, so in Christ we who are many form one body, and each member belongs to all the others.

• **Make Disciples –D-Groups**

Matthew 28:19-20 (NIV)

“Go and make disciples of all nations, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.”

What is a D-Group

- Gender Specific
- 3-5 group members
- Meeting once a week for 12-18 months
- High commitment and high accountability
- Reading the Bible and Journaling

Matthew 5:16 (ESV)

“In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.”

We must prioritize Missions and Ministry

We are all commanded to share the Gospel

We all have what unbelievers need most (and are completely deceived thinking they will find it elsewhere)

Depression - Anxiety – Loneliness – Confusion – Anger – Hatred – Suicide

62% say God accepts the worship of all religions. (Confusion)

32.0% of adults in Virginia reported symptoms of anxiety and/or depressive disorder.

VA Economic Partnership says

“The region has a population of over 180,000 and combines with the surrounding labor area to offer an impressive workforce estimated at 395,000.”

Let’s do the Math

180,000 minus the 15% that say they are evangelicals gives us

144,000 people not in a relationship with Jesus.

9.6/19.2 Gospel Conversations a year

Revelation 21:1-5
