

Hebrews 11:1-4 (ESV)

Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. For by it the people of old received their commendation. By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible.

By faith Abel offered to God a more acceptable sacrifice than Cain, through which he was commended as righteous, God commending him by accepting his gifts. And through his faith, though he died, he still speaks.

Faith is: Believing that God will do what He said, and Living as though He had already done it.

Courageous Faith: The Saving Faith of Abel Hebrews 11:1-4

I. His Faith was Accepted

Verse 4 – "Abel offered to God a more acceptable sacrifice..."

II. His Faith was Admired

Verse 4 – "...he was commended as righteous."

Genesis 4:4 (NIV)


"And Abel also brought an offering from some of the firstborn of his flock. The Lord looked with favor on Abel and his offering."
