Joshua 1:1, 6 (NIV)

“After the death of Moses, the LORD said to Joshua, Moses’ assistant: ‘Be strong and courageous, because you will lead these people to inherit the land.’”

I. The Servant Character that Shaped His Faith

Deuteronomy 34:9 (NIV)

“Now Joshua was filled with the spirit of wisdom.... So the Israelites listened to him and did what the Lord had commanded Moses.”

Mark 10:45 (ESV)

“For the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.”

II. The Spiritual Commitment that Strengthened His Faith

Joshua 1:1-3 (NIV)

After the death of Moses the servant of the LORD, the LORD said to Joshua, Moses' assistant: "Moses my servant is dead. Now then, you and all these people, get ready to cross the Jordan River into the land I am about to give to them—to the Israelites. I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses.

Joshua 1:5 (NIV)

No-one will be able to stand up against you all the days of your life. As I was with Moses, so I will be with you; I will never leave you nor forsake you.

Joshua 1:7-8 (NIV)

Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go. Do not let this Book of the Law depart from your mouth; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.
