Matthew 1:20-21 (NIV)

“But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, ‘Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins.’”

I. The Unending Promise

Verse 21 – “She will give birth to a son, and you are to *give him the name Jesus...*”

II. The Universal Problem

Verse 21 – “...because He will save His people *from their sins.*”

Romans 3:9-23 (HCSB)

Both Jews and Gentiles are all under sin, as it is written: There is no one righteous, not even one; there is no one who understands, there is no one who seeks God. All have turned away, together they have become useless; there is no one who does good, there is not even one. Their throat is an open grave; they deceive with their tongues. Vipers’ venom is under their lips. Their mouth is full of cursing and bitterness. Their feet are swift to shed blood; ruin and wretchedness are in their paths, and the path of peace they have not known. There is no fear of God before their eyes. Now we know that whatever the law says speaks to those who are subject to the law, so that every mouth may be shut and the whole world may become subject to God’s judgment. For no flesh will be justified in His sight by the works of the law, ... For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

III. The Unparalleled Provision

Verse 21 - "...He will *save His people* from their sins."

Luke 19:10 (HCSB)

For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.

John 3:17 (NIV)

For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.

I Timothy 2:3-4 (HCSB)

"... God our Savior wants everyone to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth."

Colossians 4:5 (TLB)

"Make the most of your chances to tell others the Good News...."
