I. Always Accomplished Only Through His Power.

“...him who is able... according to his power.”

Ephesians 1:18-20 (NIV)

“I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know ... his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is the same as the mighty strength he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead.”

John 15:5 (NIV)

II. Always Greater Than We Can Ask or Imagine

III. Always Begin Inside of Us and Outlive Us.

IV. Always Bring Glory to Him Alone.
